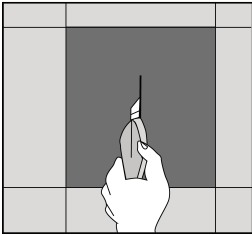


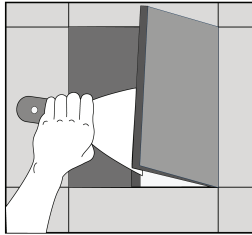
## REPAIRING DEKWALL

### REPLACING A DAMAGED TILE

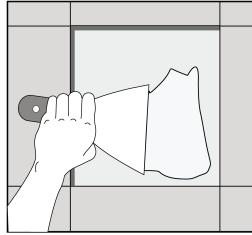
The following tools and materials are required in order to remove a tile from an installed area: Knife, chisel, trowel, scraper, levelling compound and adhesive.



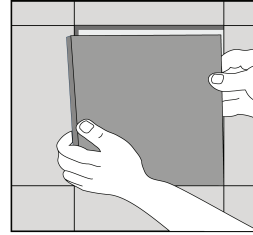
To remove the damaged tile you must cut out the center with a knife.



Remove the tile, from the center to the edges using a scraper. This method will avoid damaging the adjacent tiles.



Try to remove the tile without damaging the substrate. If this is not possible, the substrate should be filled with a suitable wall levelling product. Be cautious with this, to ensure that the substrate is completely flat and smooth.



Use a recommended contact adhesive to glue the new tile into place. Follow the installation instructions on its label.

Press the tile on the wall and remove any surplus adhesive.
